

How to find the text of an article on TheBRAIN in 5 Easy Steps

Do you have a reading list with references to lots of journal articles? The E-Journal Portal can help. Here is how to find those articles in electronic format using the E-Journal Portal.

Step 1: Once you are at the E-Journal Portal search screen, **type the name of the journal** you are looking for (e.g. Journal of Nursing Care Quality) into the search box and click "Search".

Step 2: The result list will indicate all of the sources Mohawk subscribes to where you can find the full text of the article you need. **Click on one of those sources (e.g. Academic Search Elite).** N.B. Make sure the source covers the journal year you need.

In Academic Search Elite, you will find a list of the years for which the journal articles are available in full text. **Select the publication year of interest.** Links to all of the issues published that year will then appear. (Other sources present this information slightly differently.)

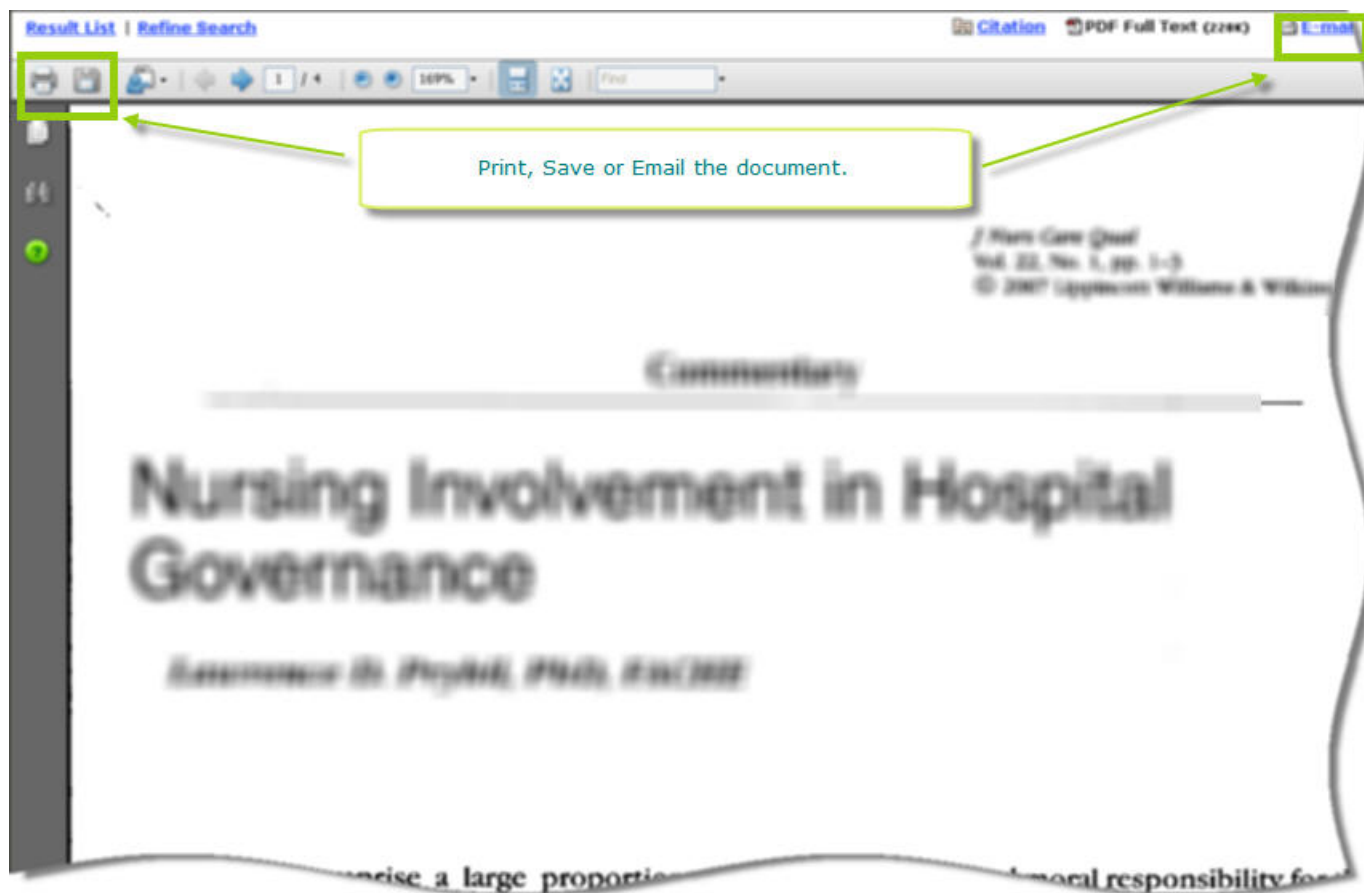
